The Remedial Investigation and Cleanup Plan submitted in July 2008, pertaining to the subject site, has been approved by the Department of Environmental Protection in accordance with the provisions of the Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation Standards Act (Act 2). This report was reviewed by or under the supervision of a Pennsylvania licensed professional geologist.

Please note the Uniform Environmental Covenants Act (Act 68 of 2007), Title 27, Pa.C.S. Chapter 65 (UECA), became effective on February 19, 2008. This law provides a standardized process for creating, documenting and assuring the enforceability of activity and use limitations on contaminated sites involving engineering and institutional controls used to achieve Act 2 standards. The Department's approval of a Final Report may need to be supported by an environmental covenant. The Department will need to approve such covenants before submittal of any Final Report. Two signed copies of the environmental covenant will need to be submitted with the Final Report, and then recorded on deeds of affected properties.
