During the public meeting for the Dillerville Yard Consolidation Project on June 19, 2008, a question was raised by a resident from the Barrcrest neighborhood regarding the non media substances located on the Lancaster County Solid Waste Management Authority's property purchased from the Lancaster Malleable Corporation.

The resident inquired about the Authority's plans for addressing the non media substances that will remain on your land after we have removed the materials from the parcel that will be used to construct the new rail facility. I believe this generally involves the area that you are in discussions with East Hempfield Township to create a natural area to include a walking and biking trail to connect the passive recreational area on Good Drive to Long's Park on Harrisburg Pike.
